Correspondence with Professor A Gerbrands and a list of prints of rock art and other images from the Kilenge area sent for display in the West New Britain Cultural Centre, Kimbe Town, West New Britain Province in 1981. The Centre was disbanded circa 2004 and the prints are presumably destroyed. (labelled 10)
