SUMMARY

This deposit consists of the records of the Federal Office of the Musicians Union of Australia.

The bulk of the records cover the 1950s to 1980s. Minutes of the Annual Conference can be found in this collection covering the years 1955 to 1977, and as well an extensive set of subject files documenting the Union's activities from the 1960s.

Further material includes Import Files detailing visits of overseas artists 1967-(1980)-1987; Arbitration Transcripts 1916(1957)-1986; a transcript of an Inquiry into the Copyright Act 1982; Rules of the Federal Office and MUA Branches, rules of other unions and of the Musicians Club of Victoria; printed membership lists 1965-1981; miscellaneous printed material; stickers mainly produced as part of the *Keep Music Live* campaign and badges.

An earlier deposit of Federal Office records is located at E156 and covers the years 1910-1967. Included are early records of a number of series contained in N93.

Minutes of Conferences for the years 1965 to 1977 have been microfilmed by the Archives and are held at M73.

CHRONICLE

The Musicians Union of Australia covers all musicians, musical librarians, copyists, composers, vocalists and musical arrangers.

The Union was registered with the Commonwealth Conciliation and Arbitration Court on 31 March 1911. It changed its name to the Professional Musicians Union of Australia on 25 August 1961 and in 1975 reverted to the title - the Musicians Union of Australia.

Federal Council meets every year at the Annual Conference and is the supreme governing body of the Union. The Federal Executive meets regularly to implement policy as determined by Council.

Currently the Union has eight Branches - Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane, Adelaide, Perth, Hobart, Newcastle and Broken Hill. Branches are administered by a Branch Committee and both the Federal and Branch Secretaries are elected for a four year term by the rank and file.
