Note:

Although it is generally accepted that trade union organisation in the coalfields existed as early as 1854, the first effective mining union was formed in New South Wales in 1860 when the workers of various mines came together to form the Hunter River District Coalminers' Mutual Protective Association in Newcastle. Representatives of South Coast Lodges met to form a union in 1878 and the Illawarra Miners' Mutual Protective Association came into being in 1885. After an abortive attempt in 1874 to form a Western District organisation, the Lithgow Lodge, Hartley District Miners' Association in 1886 became the forerunner to a district-wide association. Unionism in Broken Hill began with the opening of the field and in 1884 the Barrier Miners Association was formed, which became the Barrier Branch of the Amalgamated Miners' Association in 1886. The Illawarra, Newcastle and Lithgow unions held discussions for many years on the question of amalgamation, without success, but became branches of the Amalgamated Miners' Association, which had been formed by W. G. Spence in Victoria in 1874. After the collapse of the A.M.A., amalgamation still was not secured, but in 1895 the mining unions became affiliated with the Australian Labor Federation, a body which had come into being in Queensland.

Records of Queensland activity date to 1901 and there are references to a district body as far back as 1879, but it was not until 17 July 1906 that the first official body, the West Moreton District Miners' Federation was registered.

By 1900 there was a Victorian Coal Miners Association in existence, which was strengthened with the commencement of operations at Wonthaggi in 1909. In 1910 the union then functioning in Tasmania became a part of the Victorian District.

In 1908 - 9 the Federated Coal and Shale Workers' Union came into being, covering the three New South Wales unions. In 1913 Victoria changed the name of their organisation to the Australasian Coal Miners' Association and was registered in that name, giving coverage to all employees of coalmines throughout Australia. The Federation's registration under the Commonwealth Arbitration Act was amended on March 10, 1916 to the Australasian Coal and Shale Employees' Federation. The Broken Hill Miners affiliated with the Federation in 1917. With the movement to form a One Big Union in the 1920s, the Federation became known as the Mining Department of the Workers' Industrial Union of Australia. Although this name was never registered it is still retained in some parts, particularly Broken Hill and Wonthaggi. (See E165/8/3).
