- 9 Oct 1912 'The Small Arms Factory Employees' Association' (of Lithgow) registered in Sydney under CC&A Act (also under Arbitration (PS) Act?) (/98 & /30)
- 2 May 1917 Renamed under A(PS)Act 'The Small Arms Factory Employees & Munition Workers Association of Australia' (PS only) (/98)
- 8 Oct 1918 Renamed under A(PS)Act 'The Arms Explosives & Munitions Workers Federation of Australia (Commonwealth Services)' (/98)
- a1918-19 AEMWF absorbed NSW Branch of 'Ammunition Cordite & Explosives Employees Industrial Organisation of Australia'? (which became 'Sydney Sub-Branch')? (/35)
- a June 1926 'Clerical Sub-Branch' began at Lithgow (/15) (Aug 1930 - renamed 'Senior Officers & Clerical Sub-Branch') (/15, /35 & /107)

Federal Council AEMWF (reps NSW & Vic) first met 16 Oct 1917 (/1). From 1920 registered office was at Footscray (/1) but federal business also done at Lithgow (/98, /30, /61).

New state branches began after 1940 (E170/41, E218/339) and new sub-branches began in NSW & Vic 1942-44. A Branch Management Committee was set up in NSW Branch (/55) on 18-19 Sep 1943 to provide representation beyond Lithgow, and 'Sydney No. 2 Branch' began ca Mar 1943 (/29).



## AMALGAMATION AEMWF/FIA - NATIONAL LEVEL

Oct & Nov 1942 Conferences AEMWF/FIA re 'Metal & Munitions Workers' Union' (/4, /20)  
 Jan 1943 FCs set up Provisional Federal Council of same, which prepared rules of 'Metal & Munitions Union' (also called 'Amalgamated Ironworkers' - Munition Workers' Union') & set up 'National Executive Council' of 'MMU'

- June 1945 Amalgamation agreement signed - FAFCWU delegates at FIA N Conference - FAFCWU branches became 'chemical sub-brs' of Adelaide, Newcastle & Vic brs of FIA. ( /111, /342, /343).
- 1945-49 FIA not allowed to cover chemical workers in CCC&A - rebel FAFCWU branches continued in S.A. & Vic.
- 24 Mar 1948 FAFCWU registration cancelled.

- 27 Nov 1944 Amalgamation agreement signed by NSW Division FIA & WWWFTGWU ( /257, /394, E102/1/5) - leads to formation of 'Wireworkers' Sub-Br' of Sy No. 1 & 'Australian Wire Rope Works Sub-Br.' of Newcastle Br.? ( /322 (Sect 29))
- 18 Dec 1945 Approval in CCC&A for FIA to cover wireworkers in NSW. (IIB Vol 1 p.287).
