Note: This Company was registered in England on 5 November 1863, as the Australian Mortgage Land and Finance Co. Ltd., and changed its name to its present form in November 1910. The Company carries on business as a financial agency, stock and station agent and pastoral company with interests in New South Wales, Victoria and Queensland.

Most of this collection consists of material relating to the station properties, chiefly in NSW, which the AML and F Co. Ltd. owned or in which it had an interest, rather than the general working of the Company itself.
