In 1917 a strike was held among the employees of N. S. W. railways. Some employees opposed the strike and remained at work. Trade Unions which Deponded the strike were de-registered. After the strike two new unions formed and registered under N. S. W. law in 1918 as: N. S. W. Government Railways Permanent Way Association and the Association of Employees (Mechanical Branch of the N. S. W. Railways. These two amalgamated in 1930 to form the Railway Service Association. Previously de-registered unions were re-registered in 1920, the largest being Australian Railways Union.

1933 the R.S. A. as a State Industrial Union was re-named and registered in N.S. W. as National Union of Railwaymen, N.S. W. Branch The National Union of Railwaymen of Australia applied for Commonwealth registeration as an organisation of employees in the same year and was granted it; but an appeal against the registration was won and registration quashed.

7 December 1938 the N. U.R. of Australia was again registered under the Commonwealth law, and an appeal against its registration (May 1939) was unsuccessful.

1938 the Government Railways Transport Staff Association amalgamated with the N. U. R.

1942 Department of Main Roads (Wages Staff) Employees' Union amalgamated with the N. U. R.

1944-45 Government Tramway Electrical Branch Workers' Association amalgamated with N. U. R.
